

## **Lancaster Head of the Lune**

2400m downstream on the River Lune on Sunday November 20th 2022

Open / Junior / Masters - Men & Women: 1x, 2x, 4-, 4+, 4x, 4x+, 8+, 8x+

Run under BR Rules and the BR Rules of Racing will apply. The Head of the Lune adheres to the BR Guide to Safe Practice in Rowing.

No doubling-up of equipment or competitors within any division. No doubling-up of competitors in any event. In the draw, depending on the number of entries, crews may be banded based on ranking points. Crews may be asked to change events to give better racing.

Masters' handicaps will be applied. Result of events will be evaluated across all divisions. The overall fastest Open / Junior / Masters crews (both Mens' and Womens') will receive pennants. Event winners will receive medals subject to a minimum entry of 2 boats per event.

## **Entries and Entry Fees**

Juniors £8.50 per seat, seniors £10 per seat, coxes are free.

Entries accepted only by BROE2.

Entries close at midnight on 12th November 2022.

Payments are to be made through BROE2 by that time.

Unpaid entries will not be accepted.

The Committee may cap entries at 50 boats per division.

All competitors must be registered competitive members of British Rowing and must bring their race licences with them.

The draw will take place in the John o'Gaunt Boathouse, Halton Road Lancaster LA1 2EA from noon on 13<sup>th</sup> November.
